English



What are we learning in school?

Our English topic this half term is Patterned Stories and Poetry. We will be reading different stories and learning about their key features. The children will learn to retell familiar stories, identify key features and patterns within a story. The children will develop a knowledge of poetry on a theme and write a simple poem.

What could you do at home?

What are we learning in school?

In Maths this half term we will be learning to tell the time to o'clock and half past and measure using capacity and weight. The children will also be learning to develop their multiplication and division skills through practical work, solving number sentences and word problems. We will also be developing our knowledge of Fractions finding half of an amount.
