




Year 1 Interactive Homework Planner: Summer 1

At Broad Heath we want children to be active learners who become great thinkers, super readers, fantastic writers, are kind, considerate but most all are inspired to learn. By working together, we can make this school year a very positive and successful inspirational experience for both you and your child.

The children are to choose at least two activities from each row per week and complete in either their Homework folder, Blog or on Purple Mash. The homework must be returned to school by Wednesday the following week after the homework has been set. A minimum of 2 pieces of homework must be completed each week.

Mathematics 	<u>Multiplication</u> Write down the 5x tables? Can you work with your adults at home to make up a song/rap to help you to learn these times tables? For example: 1x5 is 5 2x5 is 10 3x5 is 15	<u>Division</u> Work these out... 15 ÷ 5 = 20 ÷ 2 = 30 ÷ 5 = 12 ÷ 2 = 22 ÷ 2 =	<u>Problem solving</u> Solve these... There are 10 biscuits in a packet. If I buy 5 packets will I have enough for 50 people to have a biscuit? There are 5 sweets in a packet. How many sweets will I have if I buy 6 packets?	<u>Fractions</u> Find $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$ of a shape. Can you cut a sandwich into $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$? Can you cut a square or circular cake in $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$?
Literacy 	<u>Story</u> Read your favourite book at home. Can you make a puppet of the characters to retell the story to your family?	<u>Character Description.</u> Who is your favourite book character? Draw a picture of your favourite character. Write as many things as you can about your favourite character. Remember to use adjectives and conjunctions!	<u>Phonics</u> Using a reading book of your choice find words for the following sounds: Green/Blue: oa, ew, oi, ire Yellow/Orange: a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e Red: ay, ee, igh Write them down on a piece of paper.	<u>Handwriting</u> Practise your cursive handwriting for the following joins/pre-joins. Remember to start at the line! Green/Blue: ock, uck, ell, ull Yellow/Orange: ay, ai, ag Red: ay, ee, igh, ow, oo Write them down on a piece of paper.
	<u>Science</u> Make a 'Spring' poster...What are the signs of spring? You can use magazines to cut out pictures and stick them to your poster. What information can you tell us about Spring?	<u>Science</u> Make a weather chart and keep a record of the weather for 1 week.
