Remember to include appropriate historic facts.</p>	<p>Use your maths measuring skills to create your own Mayan meal using ingredients representative of Mayan culture. Include a recipe.</p>	<p>Research the Mayan number system and write out a multiplication grid using their number system.</p>
	<p>Create a 3D Mayan temple with materials of your choice. Annotate the features in a creative way.</p>	<p>Re-create (or modernise) a piece of Mayan artwork or artefact using art materials of your choice. For example: crayons, watercolours, acrylic paint etc</p>	<p>Create your own Mayan god. Decide on his name and what he represents. You must include a description and image that is exciting and engages a reader.</p>	<p>Research the history of chocolate. Design and make your own chocolate bar and the packaging for it.</p>	<p>Make a headdress of a Mayan ruler (remember the bigger it is, the more important you are!).</p>	<p>Research the Mayans and present your findings in a creative way</p>
