<u>Literacy</u>	<u>Maths</u>
<p>Our Literacy units this half term will be Science Fiction Stories and Recounts. Children will learn about the key features of a science fiction story and will use this knowledge to write their own stories.</p> <p>Furthermore, children will learn about different forms of Recounts. The children will identify the features of these texts and then write their own recounts which showcases their learning.</p> <p>Each week, the children will be set a piece of homework to support their learning. The homework planner overleaf gives details about the homework tasks that your child is expected to complete each week. <u>Science</u>	<u>Topic</u>
<p>Our Science unit this half term is 'Space.'</p> <p>The children will learn about the natural world and the impact humans continue to have on it. They will explore the concept of an eco-system, developing their understanding of how different organisms survive in different parts of our planet. They will explore the topic through a variety of practical investigations.</p> <p>Keep looking out for Science links and challenges on our class blog.</p>	<p>Our topic this term is 1960's Britain.</p> <p>We will be learning about life in 1960's Britain, studying aspects including the style, music, fashion and popular culture of the period.</p> <p>We shall also have a focus on space exploration, linked to our Science topic.</p>
<u>Computing:</u> Our Computing unit this half term is 'I am a Photographer.'	
<u>Art:</u> We will be looking at 1960's Pop art and using painting and sketching skills to create our own.	
<u>SMSC:</u> Our SMSC unit this half term will be 'Why do some people believe God exists?'	
<u>Music:</u> Children will explore the music of the 1960's and create music along that theme.	
<u>PE:</u> Our PE units this half term will be Invasion Games, Netball and Swimming.
