It is great to be back at school and to be seeing so many happy faces. Your children are wonderful and they are relishing all the learning that is happening. I do however have to ask you to do the following things to ensure we all enjoy the Broad Heath experience.

- School uniform is important. The school badge is a symbol of unity and togetherness, please make sure ALL children have it on cardigans and sweatshirts.
- PE- blue tops and DARK bottoms must be worn to school on PE days.
- Swimming- Years 2-6 do swimming. This is part of the NATIONAL CURRICULUM and children MUST swim. Some schools charge for this, we do not and have a lovely warm pool so please make sure kit is sent EVERY MONDAY.
- Reading diaries have been changed at parents' request and adapted. These cost hundreds of pounds, please look after them and PLEASE listen to your children read. If they can read, they can do anything!
- School starts at 9 am, not 9.01am- lateness is not acceptable. We do offer a free breakfast club to all Reception- Y6 children from 8 o'clock every day so please sign up and use it. (Details on the blog). If absent please phone before 8.30 am.
- We have an office on the playground that is open each day if parents need help with blogs, trips, purchase of school uniform etc. It is manned by Mrs Rullay and Miss Preston and is based by Year 1 B- please use it.
- School trips- we want every child to go on trips- these ensure that your children are gaining and widening their skills and knowledge. If you need help, let us know.
- School Calendar- this is on the school website...www.broadheath.coventry.sch.uk and has all the information you need about learning. The calendar at the side tells you about trips and after school clubs- please use it.
