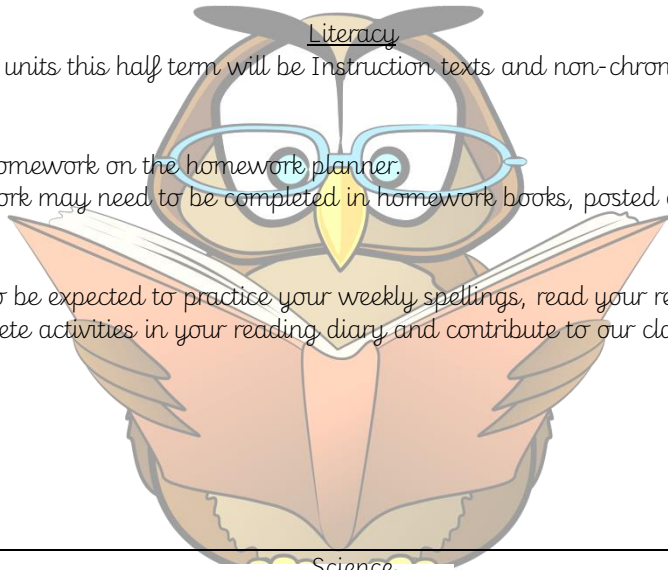

Literacy

Maths
