<b>English</b> 	Research and create a presentation on the Mayans' use of cocoa beans for money	Write a character profile of a Mayan Chief.	Create a poem about chocolate.	Write a poem that tells a day in the life of a Mayan. Remember to include appropriate historic facts.	Write a set of instructions on how to make a headdress.
	Create a 3D Mayan temple with materials of your choice. Annotate the features in a creative way.	Re-create (or modernise) a piece of Mayan artwork or artefact using art materials of your choice. For example: crayons, watercolours, acrylic paint etc	Create your own Mayan god. Decide on his name and what he represents. You must include a description and image that is exciting and engages a reader.	Research the history of chocolate. Design and make your own chocolate bar and the packaging for it.	Make a headdress of a Mayan ruler (remember the bigger it is, the more important you are!).
