



Broad Heath Charging Policy

Under the law, the governors may choose to charge for some activities. Our policy is as follows:

No charge will be made for:

- education in school hours;
- provision of learning materials connected to the National Curriculum, this includes cooking, sewing, art materials etc
- swimming tuition fees or related transport costs for sporting events.
- breakfast club provision .
- after school clubs led by school staff.

Contributions from parents are permissible for:

- board and lodging on residential visits, although we will partly subsidise these trips according to our PPG plan.(See website)
- costs of specialised individual or small group music tuition;
- costs related to wilful breakage and loss of and/or damage to school property e.g. books and equipment. **The costs will be negotiated with the parents.**
- costs of educational day visits in support of the curriculum and development of the child, although if we do ask for a contribution these will be heavily subsidised by the school.
- A small charge may be made for extra-curricular activities to cover costs to the school although PPG children may get these sessions free.
- Late pick up of children from school (see separate policy).

Children of parents who do not contribute for whatever reason will not be treated any differently. If a particular activity cannot take place without financial help from parents this will be explained at the planning stage to all parents.
