Research it and create an information poster.	The Japanese alphabet is not like the one we use in England. In fact they have 3: hiragana, katakana, kanji. Find out about the differences between the three and how they are used.	Find out about the Samurais – who were they? What job did they fulfil? How were they trained? What equipment did they carry? Draw and label a Samurai soldier.	Japanese technology: what sort of things have the Japanese invented? What is their impact on the world? Design, draw and label your own invention.
