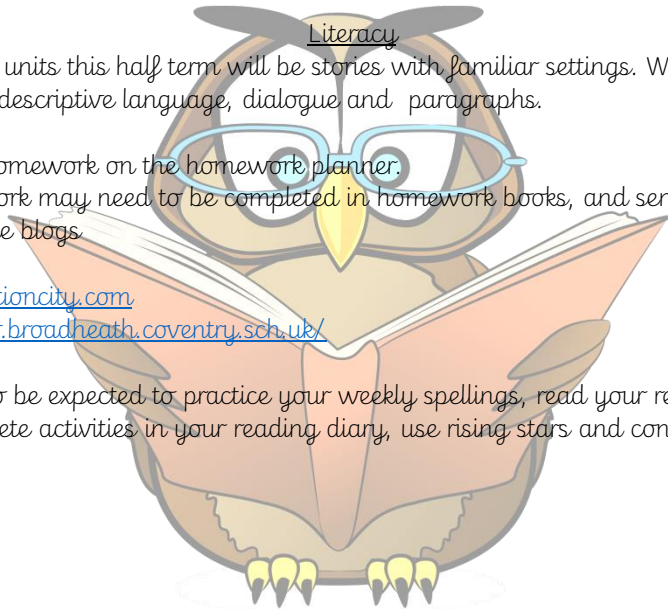
Literacy

You will also be expected to practice your weekly spellings, read your reading book daily, complete activities in your reading diary, use rising stars and contribute to our class blog.



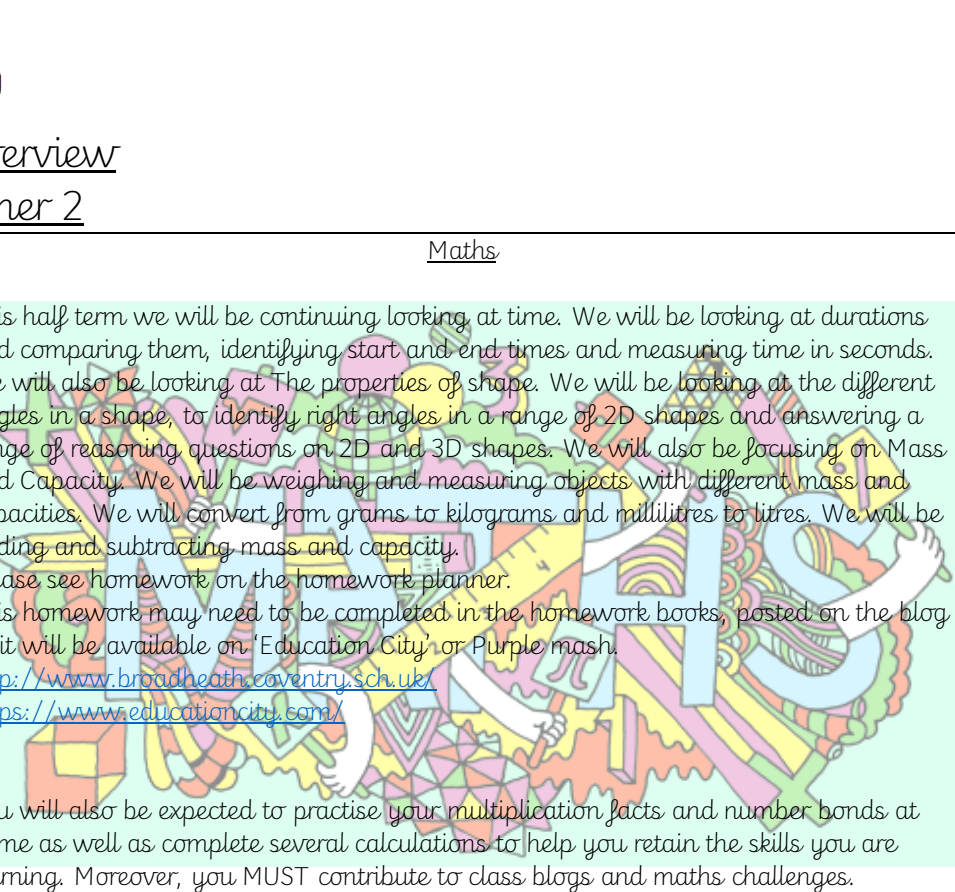
Maths

This half term we will be continuing looking at time. We will be looking at durations and comparing them, identifying start and end times and measuring time in seconds. We will also be looking at The properties of shape. We will be looking at the different angles in a shape, to identify right angles in a range of 2D shapes and answering a range of reasoning questions on 2D and 3D shapes. We will also be focusing on Mass and Capacity. We will be weighing and measuring objects with different mass and capacities. We will convert from grams to kilograms and millilitres to litres. We will be adding and subtracting mass and capacity. Please see homework on the homework planner.

Our Topic this half term is The United Kingdom. We will be going to London to explore the city, as well as learning map skills and comparing bridges while at school.

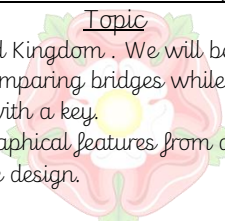
- To create a map with a key.
