With the cost of living crisis and the spiraling fuel crisis, I am proposing that there will be a cap maximum of £30 a year for all trips. To get this deal, you need to pay the money in one lump sum by October half term 2022 FOR EACH CHILD. (Yes, you can send money weekly)So is this value for money? A trip to Weston would cost around £20, a trip to Drayton Manor would be over £30. Trips to a local park on a coach cost over £5, so it all adds up. Children on free school meals also will get a discount so please apply for FSM if entitled. Please let staff know if this is something that would help.

- HOLIDAYS- no holiday will be authorized by the school in term time. It could lead to a fine. We have 13 weeks off a year, which is plenty of time to take a holiday. I understand your concerns about cheaper flights but please talk to politicians about this.
- Children who are absent from school. You MUST phone through to the office. The office is open from 7.30 am every day. You MAY get a home visit from school. This is done as we need to ensure you are ok as well as your children, offered support and share we are concerned about their absence. More home visits happen after a school trip because too many children take the following day off which is unacceptable.
- PE Tops- all children to wear blue PE tops. As from September **dark bottoms must be worn.** Again, to support parents financially all PE tops will be sold at £3 until October half term when they will go back to full price- £4.
- If people who pay for School dinners pay in advance and for the whole term, we will charge £2 a day. If you want to pay weekly this will be £10.50 a week as from September.
