- We break up at normal time on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October and come back on TUESDAY 1<sup>st</sup> November. Breakfast club will be as normal at 8 am and every child is welcome to attend.
- We have had lots of requests for homework club after school. Time will be allocated for all. This is not a club for life and children will be given 5 week blocks when space is available. Children on PPG funding will get extra time.
- Sat School for PE is proving very popular, again this is a FREE club, all children will be given the chance to attend should they wish.
- FINAL CLUBS of the half term next week and there are NO CLUBS last week before any holiday. If you fail to pick your child up/make alternative arrangements this could lead to a fine if left at school.
